

What is “In Forma Pauperis?”

In Forma Pauperis is a process a court uses to allow someone to file a case without paying the required court fees because the person filing cannot afford to pay them.



How do I ask the Court to give me permission to file my case In Forma Pauperis?



To begin this process, you must first prepare the document you wish to file and then complete two forms:

- 1) a petition – a formal request to the Court
- 2) an affidavit – a written statement that someone swears to under oath

Instructions for completing the In Forma Pauperis Petition

The numbers below match the blanks on the “In Forma Pauperis Petition” form. Please see the matching number for information about how to complete each section of the form. The language and format of the form should not be changed.

- (1) Fill in the type of court in which you are filing your case – District Court or Circuit Court. Contract disputes, damages or recovery of property under \$25,000, and small claims (under \$5,000) can be brought in District Court. Most other cases should be brought in Circuit Court. For example, you would file for divorce, real property (land) disputes, and issues related to wills and estates in Circuit Court.
- (2) Fill in the county in which you are filing your case.
- (3) Fill in your name. Because you are the person making the formal request to the court, you are the plaintiff.
- (4) This blank is for the case number. You will have to leave this blank until the court clerk gives you a case number.
- (5) Fill in your name.
- (6) Fill in the kind of case you want to open with the Court. For example: “Divorce” “Contract Enforcement” or “Wills and Estates”. Keep in mind that the Court cannot waive fees for cases involving slander (damaging one’s reputation through false statements), libel (damaging one’s reputation through written or published false materials), or malicious prosecution (brining a case without facts against another to harm them).
- (7) Fill in the same thing you placed in (6) here.
- (8) Your signature goes here. You do not have to sign this form in front of a notary public, but your affidavit will have to be signed in front of a notary public.
- (9) Fill in your mailing address.
- (10) Fill in your phone number.

COMES NOW the Plaintiff, (5) _____, *pro se*, who hereby petitions the court for Leave to Proceed *In Forma Pauperis* and does allege and state as follows:

1. That Plaintiff, a resident of the State of Arkansas, has prepared and desires to file with this Court (6) _____.

2. That Plaintiff has completed an Affidavit in Support of Request to *Proceed In Forma Pauperis* setting out his/her income and assets. Plaintiff's Affidavit accompanies this petition.

3. That Plaintiff's income barely suffices to meet the costs of life's daily essentials and includes no allotment that could be budgeted to pay for court fees and costs incident to this proceeding.

4. That Plaintiff has no other income in addition to that described in his/her Affidavit and no means of paying such costs without being reduced to total impoverishment.

5. That Plaintiff believes that he/she is entitled to the relief requested in the accompanying (7) _____ and that such action is not brought for a frivolous or malicious purpose.

WHEREFORE, Plaintiff prays that the court enter an order allowing the Plaintiff to prosecute this action *In Forma Pauperis* and that the Plaintiff may have the necessary writs and processes without payment of fees or costs for the same.

Instructions for Completing In Forma Pauperis Affidavit

The letters below match the blanks on the “In Forma Pauperis Affidavit” form. Please see the matching letter for information about how to complete each section of the form. The language and format of the form should not be changed.

- (A) Fill in the type of court in which you are filing your case – District Court or Circuit Court. Contract disputes, damages or recovery of property under \$25,000, and small claims (under \$5,000) can be brought in District Court. Most other cases should be brought in Circuit Court. For example, you would file for divorce, real property (land) disputes, and issues related to wills and estates in Circuit Court.
- (B) Fill in the county in which you are filing the case.
- (C) Fill in your full name.
- (D) This blank is for the case number. You will have to leave this blank until the court clerk gives you a case number.
- (E) Fill in your full name.

For questions 1- 5, read carefully and provide answers to each question. Keep in mind that this is a sworn statement to the Court and any false or misleading information may be punishable by law.

Once you have completed the form, you will need to sign it in front of a notary public. Most Circuit Clerk’s offices have a notary public on staff or in a nearby office who can notarize your form free of charge. Do not sign this form until you are in front of notary public. The notary will fill in the section below your signature.

Do not fill in #6 unless you are in jail or prison. If you are in jail or prison, this will need to be completed by an official at your facility.

Once you have completed these forms, you will take them and the document you wish to file with the court to the court clerk's office for your county. (Be sure to keep copies for yourself.) The clerk's office will file them at no cost to you. If the judge finds that you cannot afford court costs, the judge will sign an order allowing you to move forward with your case without court fees. Once the order is filed, you may move forward with your case.

If the judge finds that you cannot afford court costs and that you have a valid case, the judge will sign an order allowing you to move forward with your case without court fees. Once the order is filed, you may move forward with your case. You will need to take another copy of the document you wish to file to the clerk's office to be filed to open your case.
